Summary:

The Extrusion Technician is responsible for supporting various production and manufacturing operations as assigned. This role exposes technicians to the Extrusion process quickly to develop the skills needed to assemble, maintain, and disassemble lines while having an established technical aptitude.

Primary Duties / Responsibilities: to include, but are not limited to the following:

- Work on a team to assist and perform technical tasks to keep manufacturing lines running
- Develop and expand technical skill level
- Potential focus areas could include:
 - Operating hand tools and power tools
 - o Operating extrusion/injection molding equipment, ovens, saws, grinders, etc.
 - o Product support: cutting, trimming, inspecting, cleaning, repairs & assembly
 - Equipment maintenance inspection, disassembly, cleaning, repairs, & assembly
 - Facility support cleaning, repairs, painting, plumbing & construction trade support as needed
 - Painting and coating
 - Operating forklift, tractor, loading and pulling trailer
- Follow all safety and company policies/guidelines (including tobacco free facilities)
